Guiding Principles for Discernment

These principles help us listen to one another—and to God's movement among us—with openness, care, and courage.

1. Prepare to Listen

Center yourself with openness and intention.

- Be present to our current reality
- Breathe and self-regulate
- Bring hope and acceptance

2. Lead with Compassion

Approach others with grace and empathy.

- Practice kindness and compassion
- Assume good intent—we're all trying
- Offer unconditional regard and tenderness

3. Listen with Care

Engage others with respect and curiosity.

- Listen attentively and value each voice
- Welcome diverse thoughts and experiences
- Stay curious and build trust

4. Create Brave Space

Deepen connection through vulnerability and joy.

- Take risks in sharing
- Embrace vulnerability
- Delight in getting to know one another better

5. Communicate with Integrity

Speak in ways that reflect our values and strengthen our life together.

- Speak with respect, honesty, and transparency
- Communicate clearly and frequently
- Encourage two-way dialogue and active listening
- Use language that builds up rather than tears down
- Resist harmful or hurtful gossip
